His crossover success, reaching more than 150 million YouTube viewers, underscores his emergence as one of the most important and popular artists to surface in years. To fans of virtuoso musicianship, it is McKee's attention to song structure and melodic content that elevates him above the rest. To fans of popular music, McKee entertains both the eye and the ear as he transforms the steel string guitar into full orchestra via his use of altered tunings, tapping, partial capos, percussive hits, and his signature two-handed technique.
